Presiding Bishop Elizabeth Eaton's recent letter to the church included these words: "In 1527 the plague returned to Wittenberg, Germany. Two hundred years earlier the plague had swept across Europe killing up to 40 percent of the population. Understandably, people were anxious and wondered what a safe and faithful response might be. In answer to this, Martin Luther wrote "Whether One May Flee From a Deadly Plague." In it, he emphasized the duty to care for the neighbor, the responsibility of government to protect and provide services to its citizens, a caution about recklessness, and the importance of science, medicine and common sense." Those words are as relevant today as they were in the 16th century. To that end we will provide weekly updates about cancelations of worship services and other meetings. Westwood House Campus Ministry Food Pantry -

There is a renewed need for help for the Westwood

House Food Pantry. Because of school closings and job cutbacks, students will be especially vulnerable over the next few weeks. Westwood's pantry shelves will need constant restocking. **Needed by the food pantry:** rice, canned beans (not GREEN beans), canned veggies (not GREEN beans), canned tomatoes, canned corn, refried beans, packaged chicken (can or individual serve packets, they have a lot of tuna), easily-prepared meals & snacks, protein bars such as CLIF, LUNA, LARA, KIND, etc.; peanut butter, jelly, bread, crackers, hearty soups and stews, Cup of Soup, breakfast cereals, small packages of fruit and applesauce, pasta and sauce, packaged mac & cheese (especially individual serve & microwaveable), granola or breakfast bars. **Other items for the pantry:** bar soap, small toothpastes, toilet paper packages (4-roll), feminine hygiene products, deodorant, shampoo, disposable razors, tooth brushes. There is a clear tub in the Narthex to receive contributions, and we will make sure they get delivered to Westwood House.
